However, after moving to the HDU, liquid food was introduced through the feeding tube on the fifth day, which caused significant stomach discomfort. A CT scan and scope revealed inflammation in the stomach, but thankfully, there are no other complications.

The stomach specialist, Dr. Lau, is closely monitoring him and has reinstated TPN (total parenteral nutrition) alongside anti-inflammatory medication to help his stomach recover. Please pray for the inflammation to subside quickly & for the doctors to find the right nutrition to restore his stomach function

We also ask for your prayers that his recovery will continue to progress well without any complications, allowing him to be moved to a normal ward soon and eventually return home to rest and recover fully.

May the Lord, our Healer and Deliverer, continue to strengthen him, release him from all discomfort, and guide his complete restoration.
